- 4. Judgment in favor of Petitioner is awarded in the amount of \$52479, as set forth in Section III of the Marital Settlement Agreement (Cash Payment). The statutory interest rate shall apply as provided in Section 568-4(A) NMSA 1978.
- 5. Petitioner's name is restored to the former name of Theresa Lucille Hernandez.
